Project description:

Art In Movement is an innovative artistic project planned to take place over a period of 30 days, transforming an exhibition space into a constantly evolving universe, recalling the infinity and incessant dynamics of the universe. Art In Movement is an ambitious art installation designed to transform an ordinary exhibition space into a constantly evolving universe. Inspired by the concepts of impermanence, infinity and the dynamism of the universe, this project aims to capture the very essence of artistic creation in action, challenging traditional notions of a finished and static work of art.

Concept:

At the heart of this project is the installation of paint cans suspended above a white canvas spread on the floor of the exhibition space. These pots, pierced in their bottom, will let the paint slowly drip onto the canvas, thus drawing a constantly changing landscape. Visitors will be invited to witness the evolution of this work, but also to interact with the space in a respectful way, in order to be an integral part of the creative process.

Procedure:

Day 1-5: Installation and start of the exhibition

- Installation of the space with the installation of canvases and paint cans.
- Opening of the exhibition to the public, allowing you to see the first pours of paint creating random patterns.

Day 6-20: Evolution phase

- Every day, new pots of different colors will be added at varying heights, introducing new dynamic elements to the work.
- Daily cultural mediation sessions will explain to the public the concept of the work and invite them to reflect on the notion of art in movement and the beauty of impermanence.

Day 21-29: Public interaction and participation

- Organization of workshops where visitors can create their own pots of paint to hang, under the supervision of the artistic team, thus adding their personal touch to the collective work.
- Setting up an interactive zone away from the main installation, where participants can experiment with similar materials to understand the creative process.

Day 30: Closing and Transformation

- The last day of the exhibition will be marked by a closing event, where a moment of collective reflection on the lived experience will be offered.
- Announcement of a future project where the final canvas will be exhibited, after drying, in a dedicated location, allowing a reinterpretation of the work in a different setting.

Goals:

- Question the notion of a finished work of art and the idea of continuous creation.
- Engage the public in the artistic process, emphasizing the importance of the creative act as much as the final work.
- Explore the impact of random elements and time on artistic creation.

Materials Needed:

- Large canvases.
- Cans of paint in various colors.
- Suspension system for pots with a mechanism allowing height adjustment and control of paint flow.
- Exhibition space suitable for an installation of this scale.

Conclusion:

Art In Mouvement aims to offer an immersive and evolving experience, where art and its audience are in constant interaction. This project aspires not only to push the boundaries of artistic expression but also to create a space for reflection on time, space and our role in the creation and interpretation of art.
